Note: The black and gold decals for the fuselage and wings, plus the checkerboard tail decal have been deliberately lengthened to accommodate variations in model dimensions and profiles



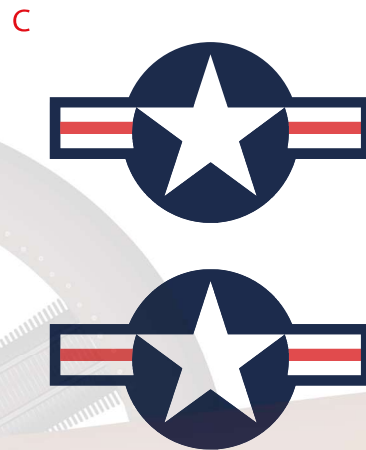

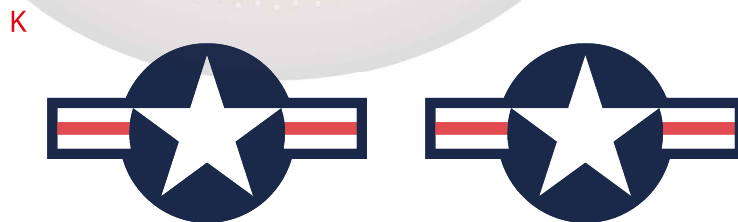
