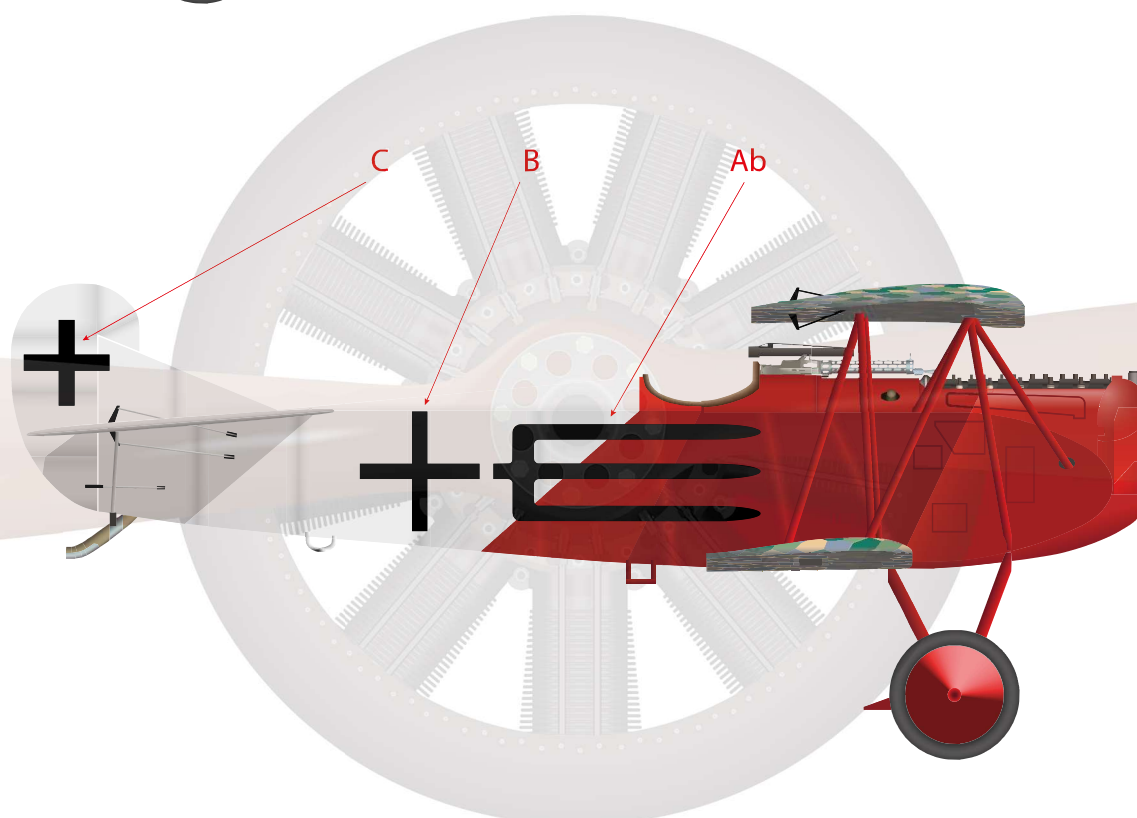
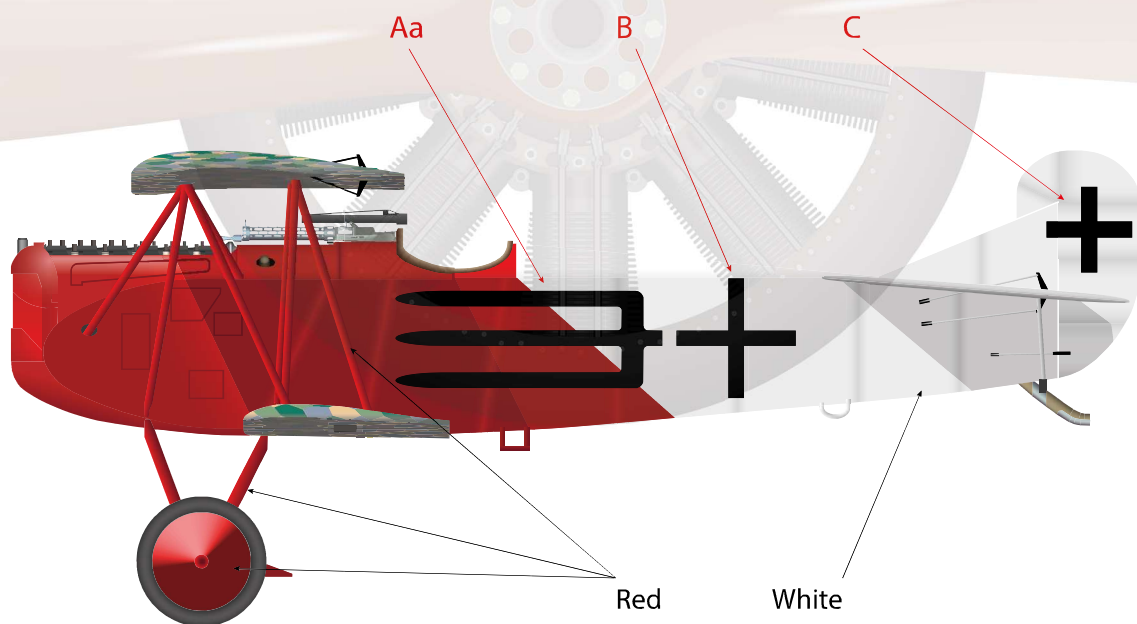


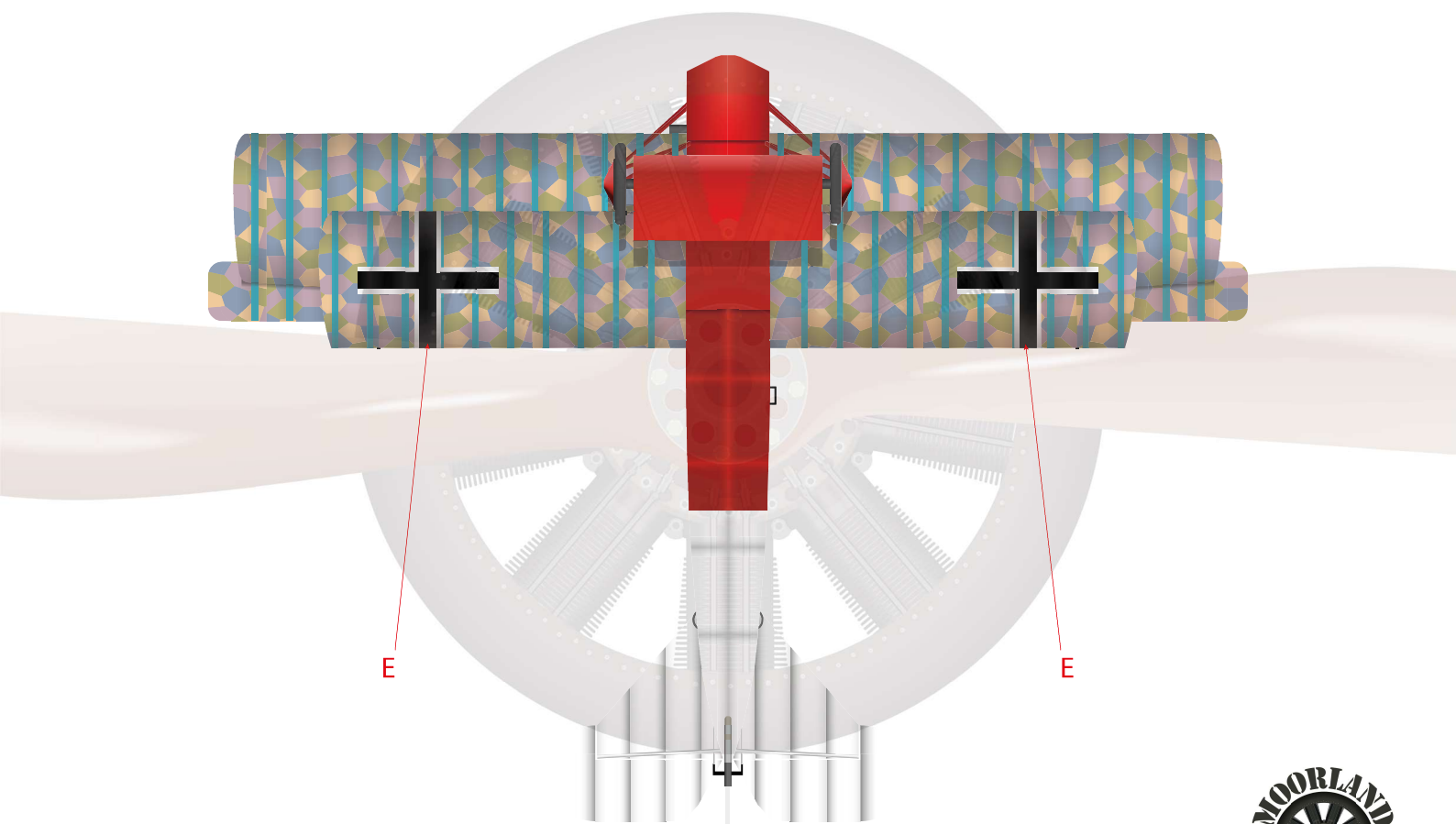
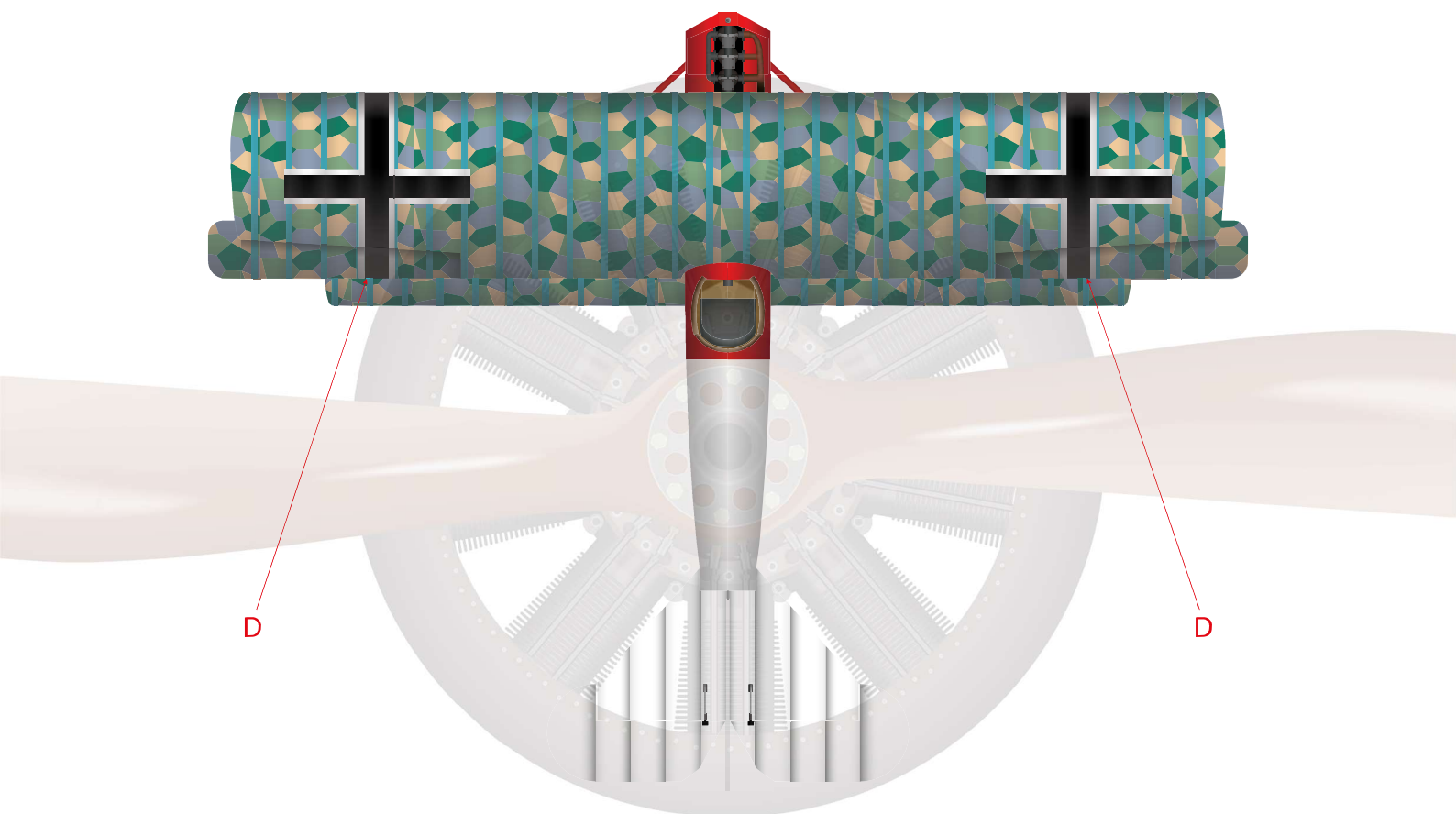
Fokker D.VII (Alb) of Jasta 43, July - August 1918.

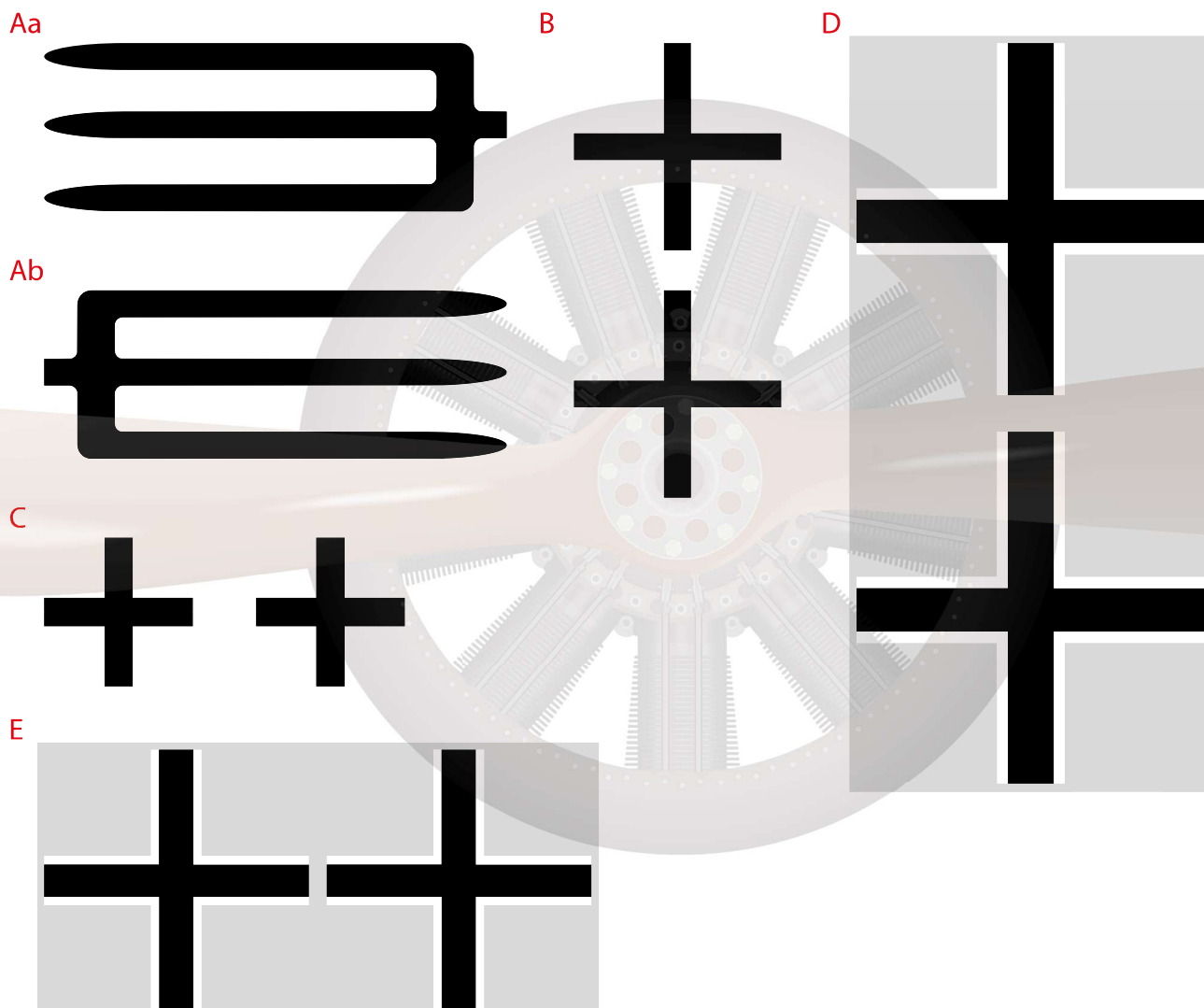
