Pilots Otto Creutzmann (8 victories) & Josef Raesch (7 victories). Two of Josef Raesch's victories were over allied aces. He was also the first pilot to use a parachute in combat.

This set contains white decals on a transparent background. A light grey background has been added to help visualise these decals. This is not included in the final product.

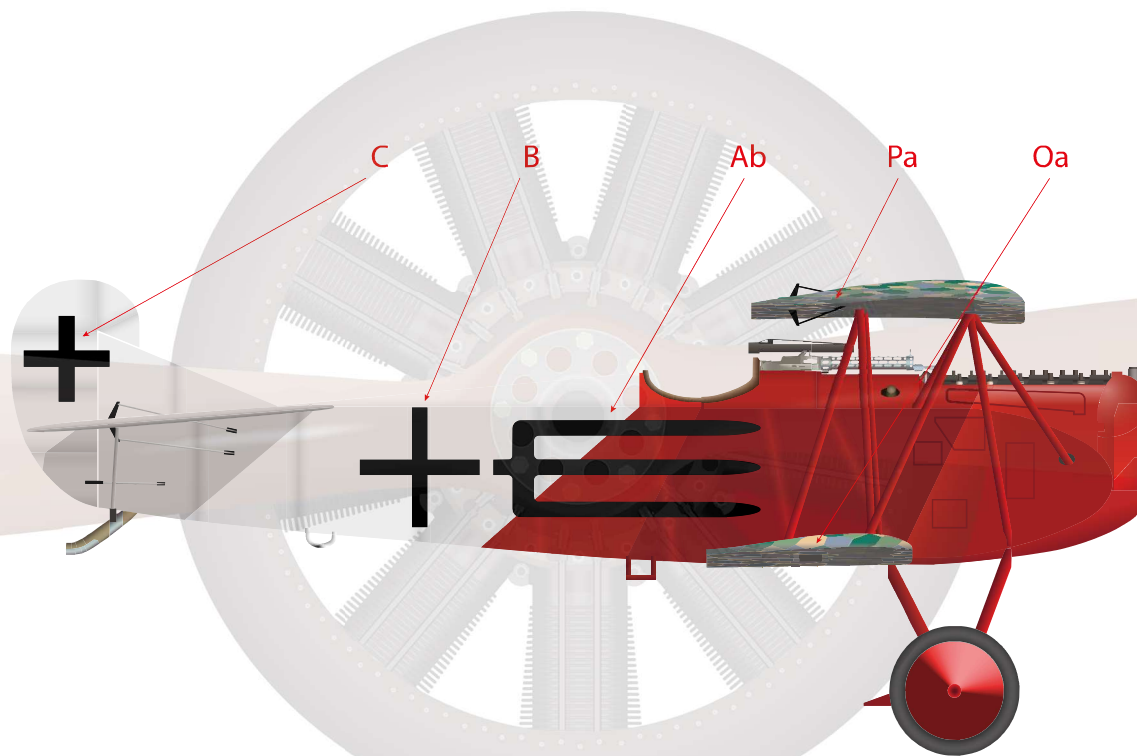
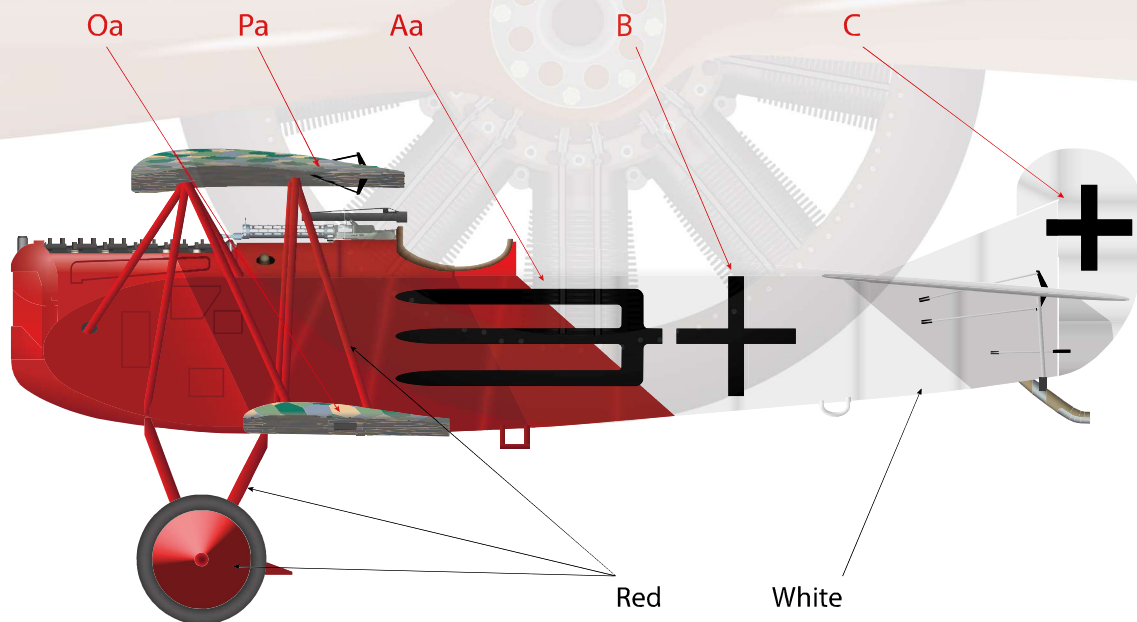
Decals L: 24 provided for aileron upper and lower surfaces

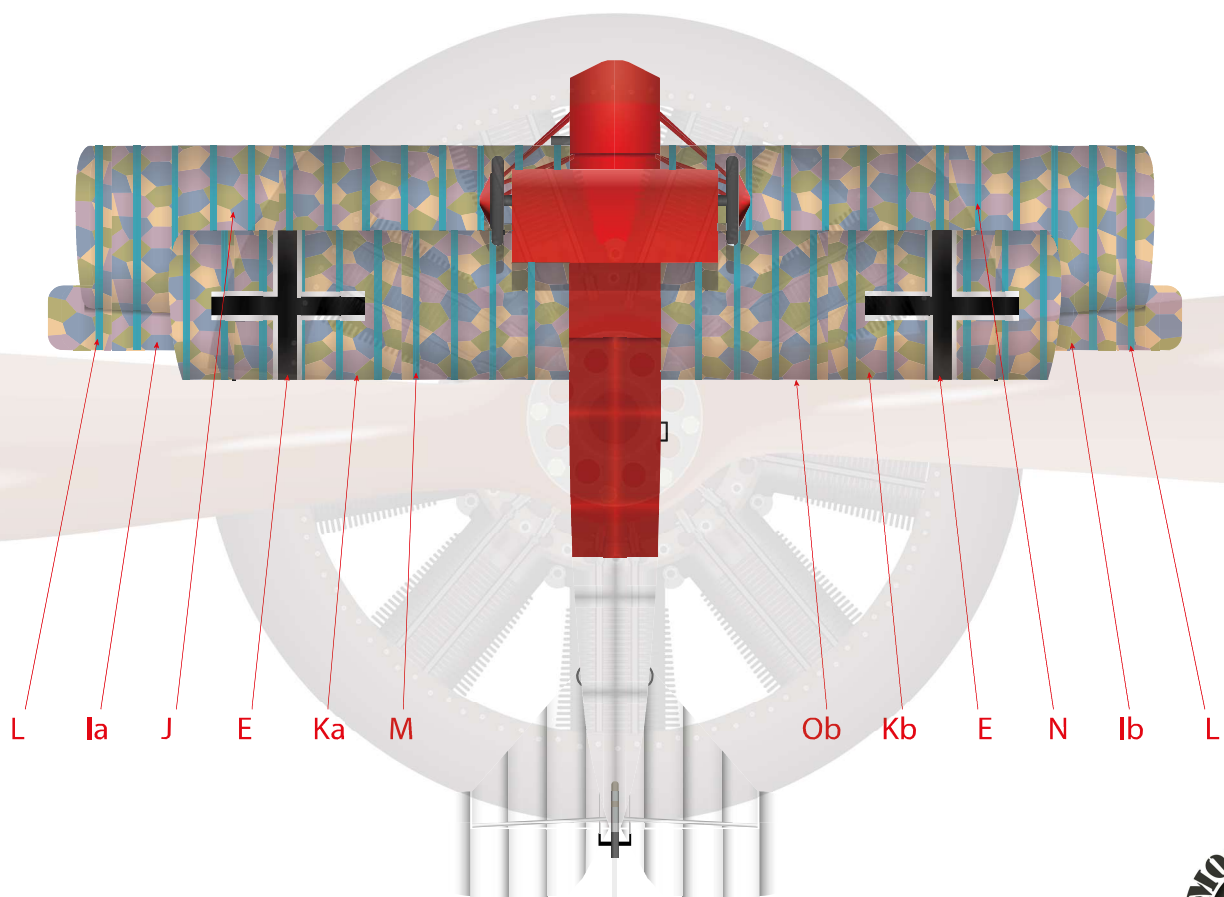
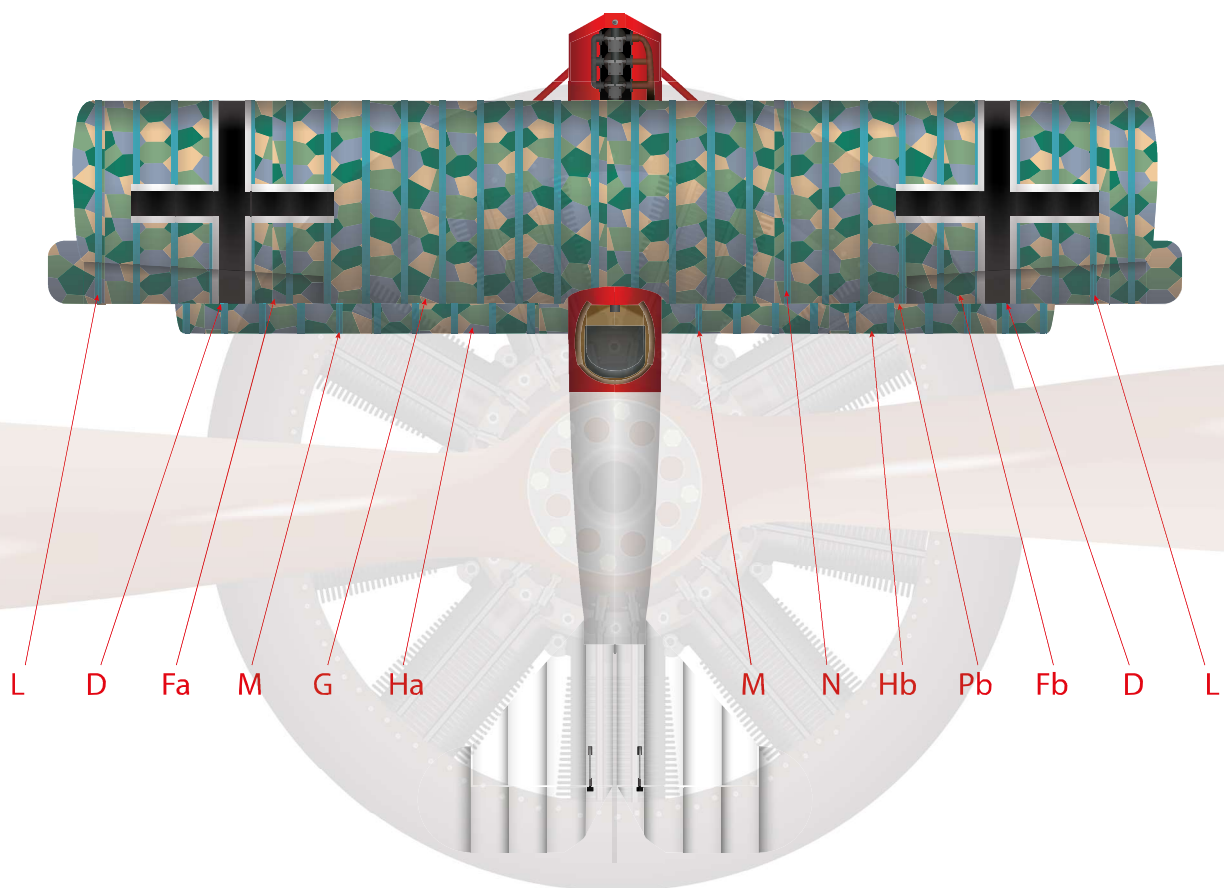
Decals M: 40 provided for lower main wing upper and lower surfaces

Decals Pa & Pb (2 of each) to be placed on circumference of upper main wing & ailerons along leading & trailing edges

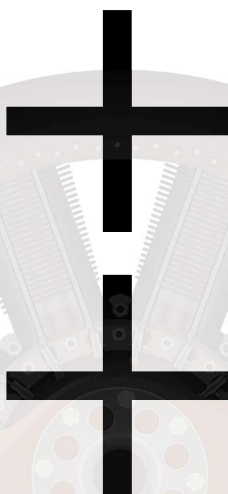
