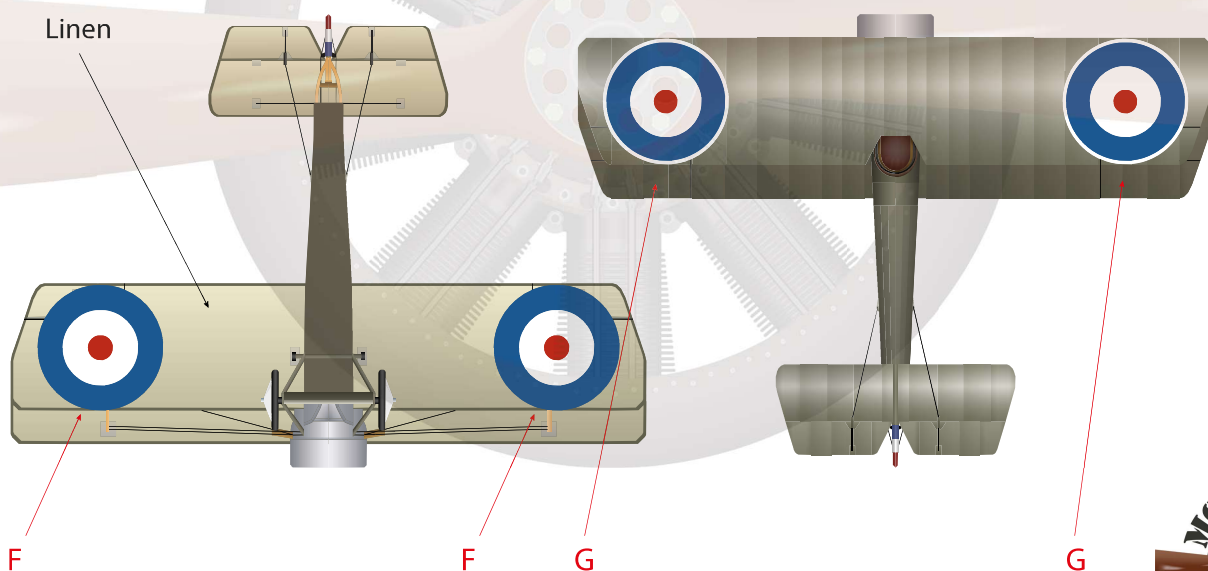
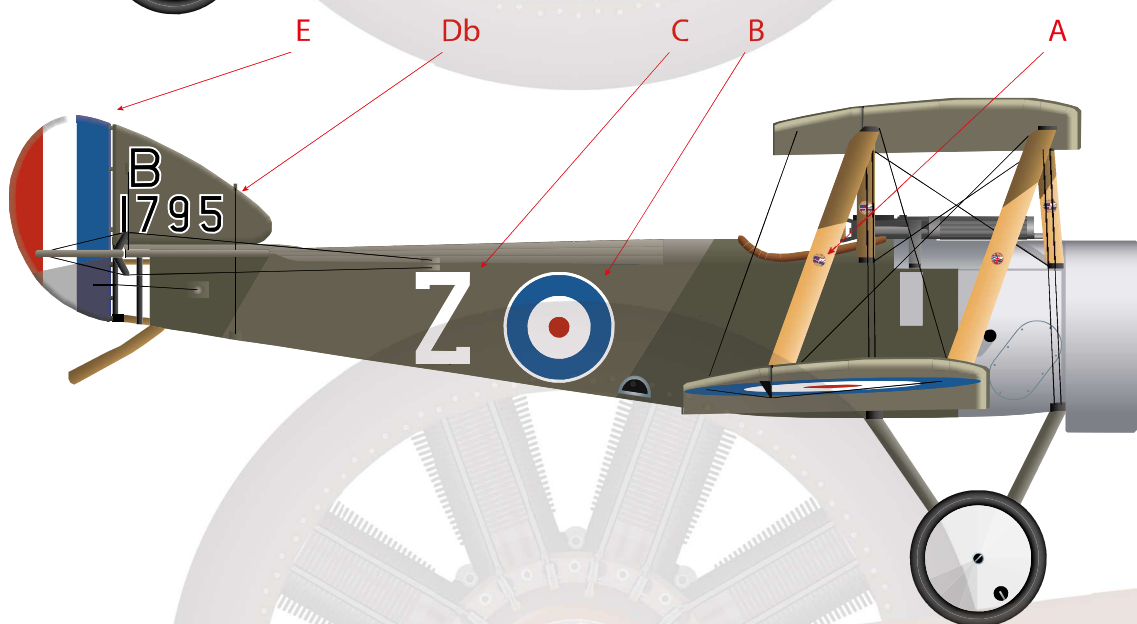
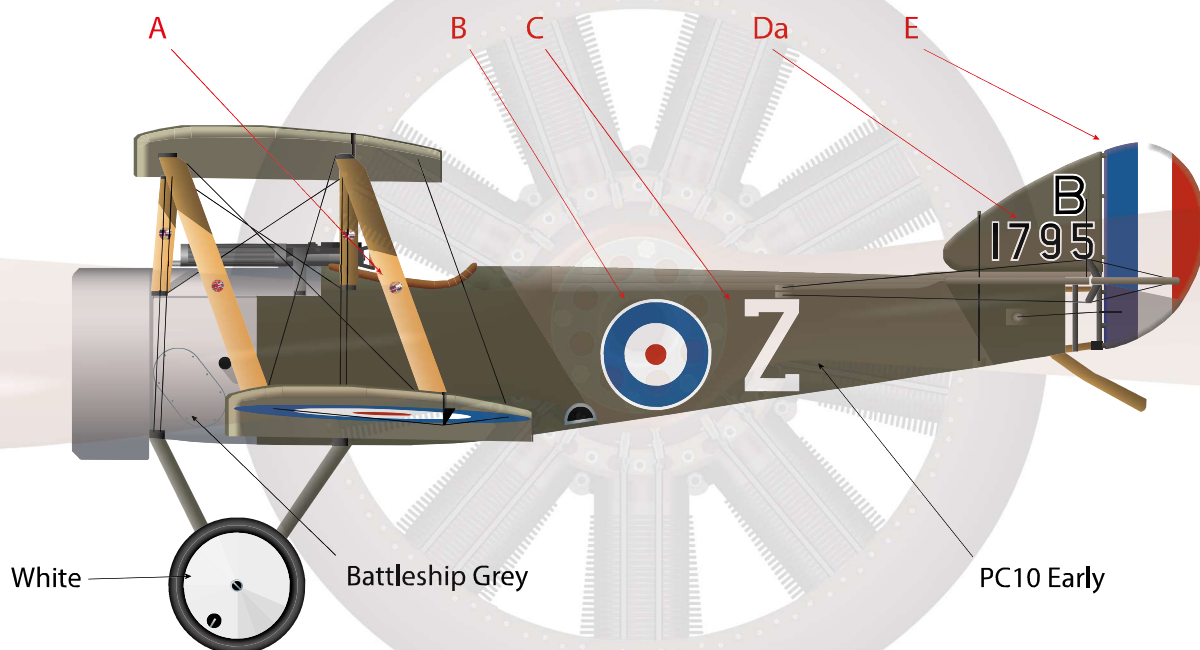
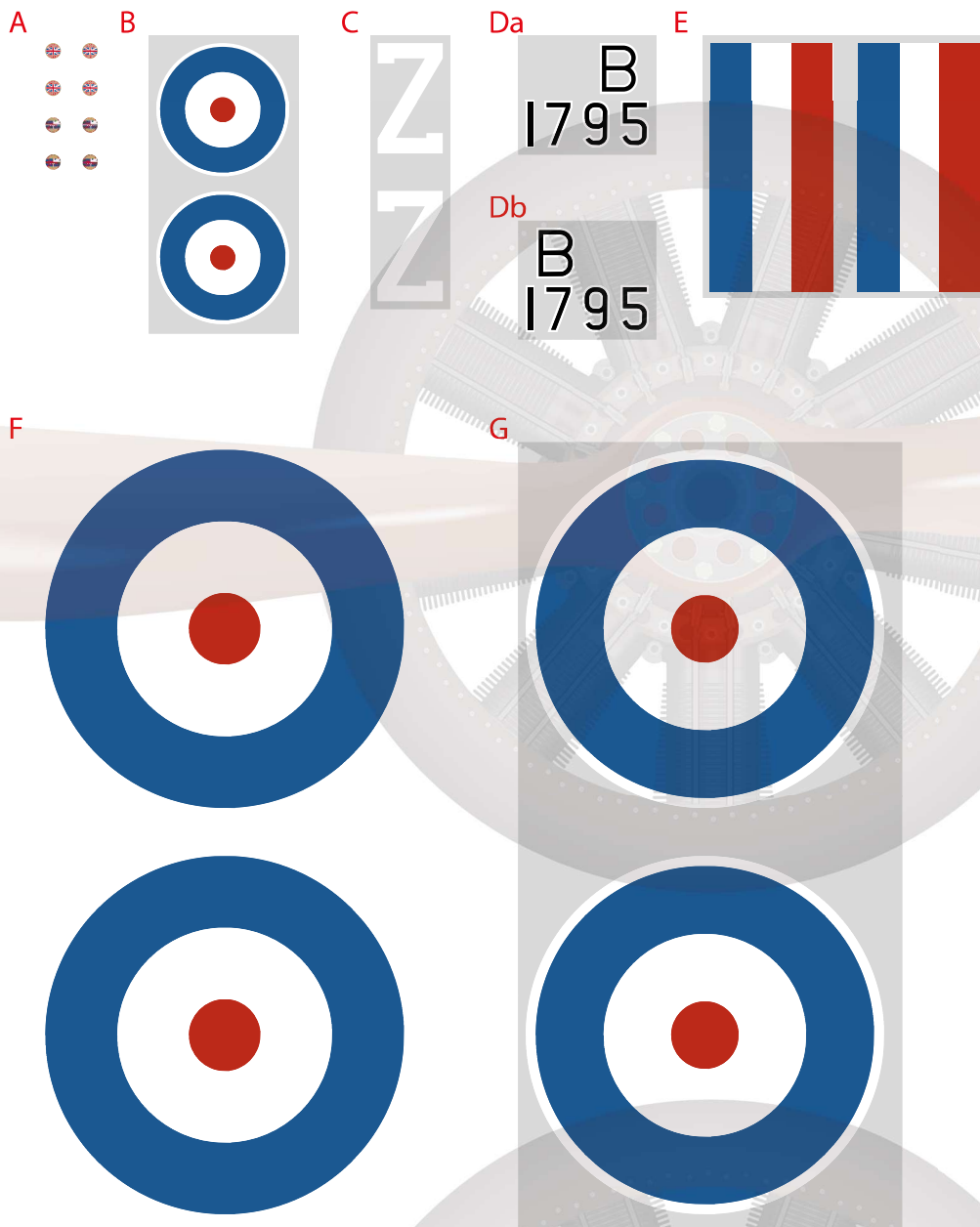


Sopwith Scout (Pup) B1795 of No. 46 Squadron, Aug - Sept 1917. Built by the Standard Motor Company
