

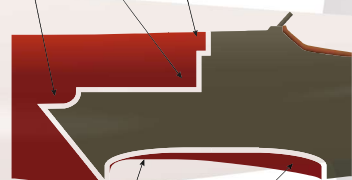
SE.5a A8898 of No. 56 Squadron RFC, May 1917, Amiens, France.

Pilot Captain Albert Ball: Accrued a total of 44 kills in WWI, 11 in SE.5a's & 31 in Nieuports. He died on the 7th May 1917 flying this aircraft. He was posthumously awarded the Victoria Cross.

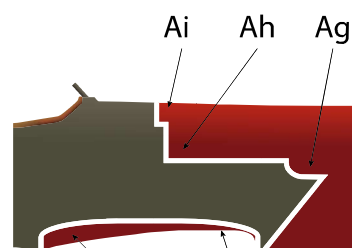
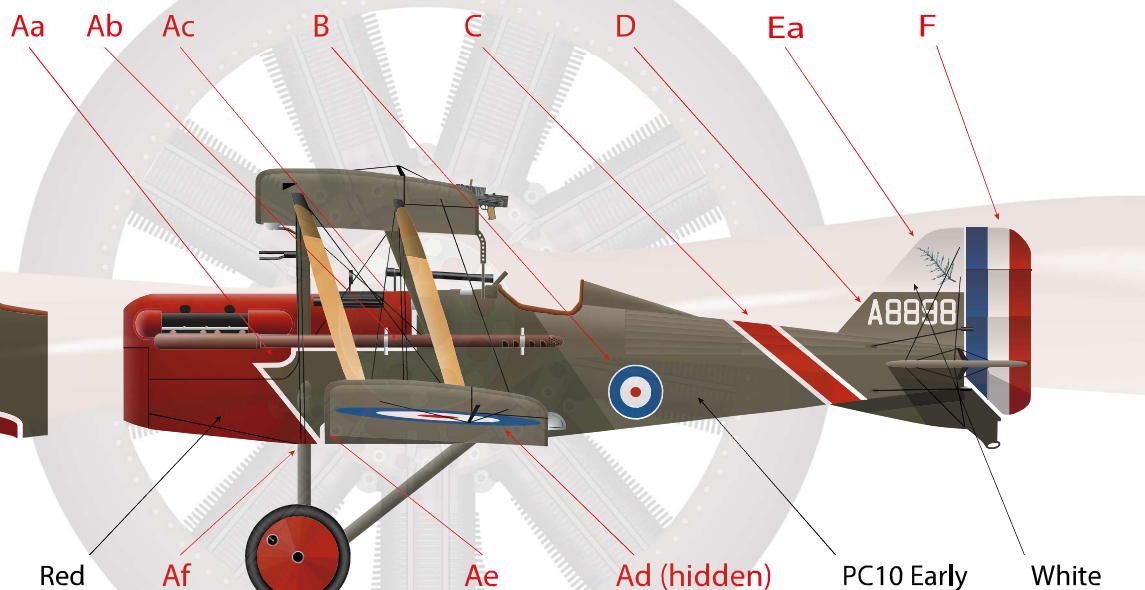
