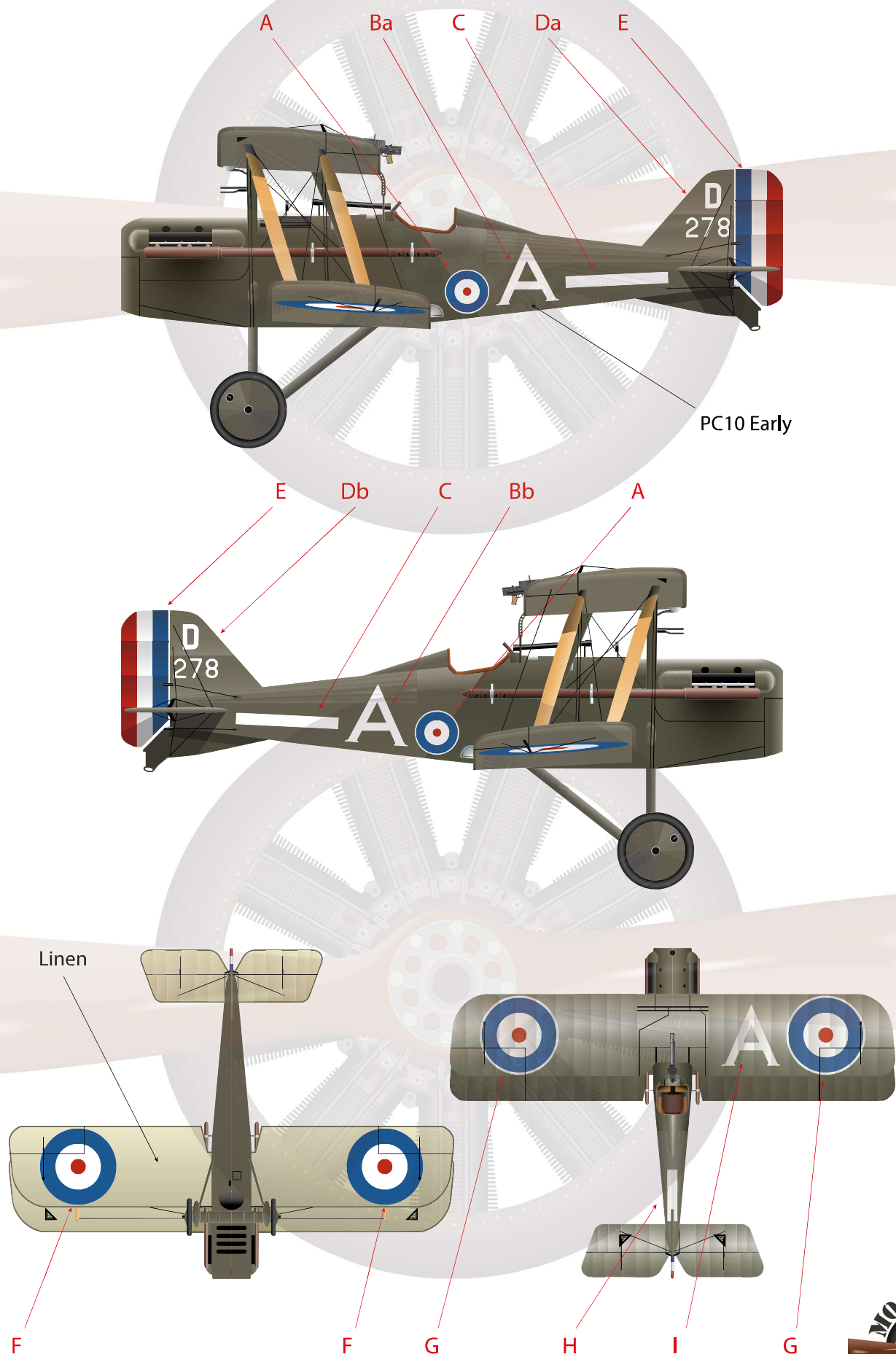
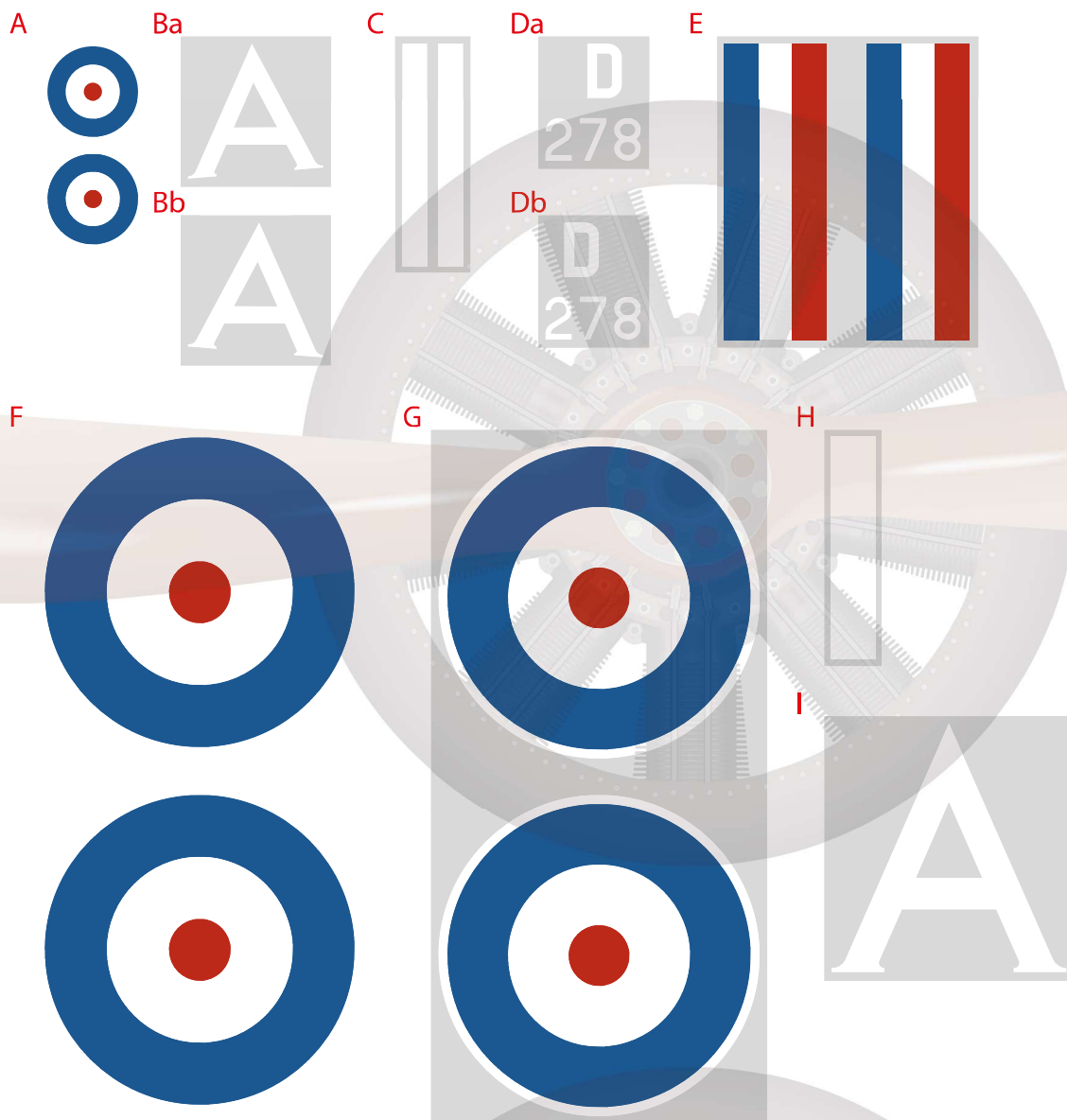


SE.5a D278 of No. 74 Squadron RFC, May 1918, Saint-Omer, France.
