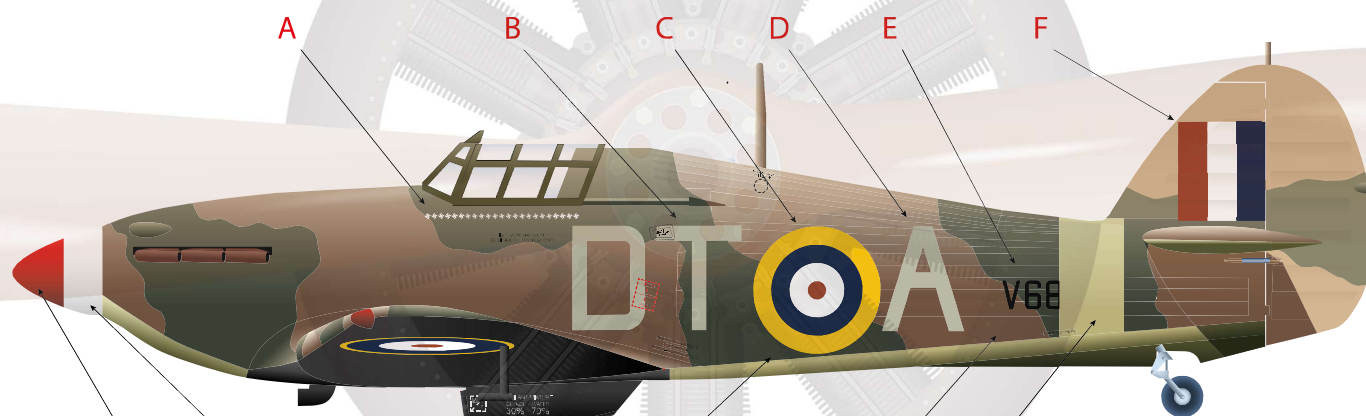


Hurricane Mk.1A V6864 of No. 257 Squadron, RAF North Weald, November 1940.

Pilot Squadron Leader Robert R Stanford-Tuck: Accrued a total of 29 kills, 2 shared, 6 probable & 6 damaged during WWII. He was shot down and taken prisoner on the 28 January 1942. This was the second Hurricane used by this fighter ace.

Notes: This set contains white decals on a transparent background. A light grey background has been added to help visualise these decals. This is not included in the final product.

Many sources show the sky band at the rear of the fuselage painted over the aircraft serial numbers

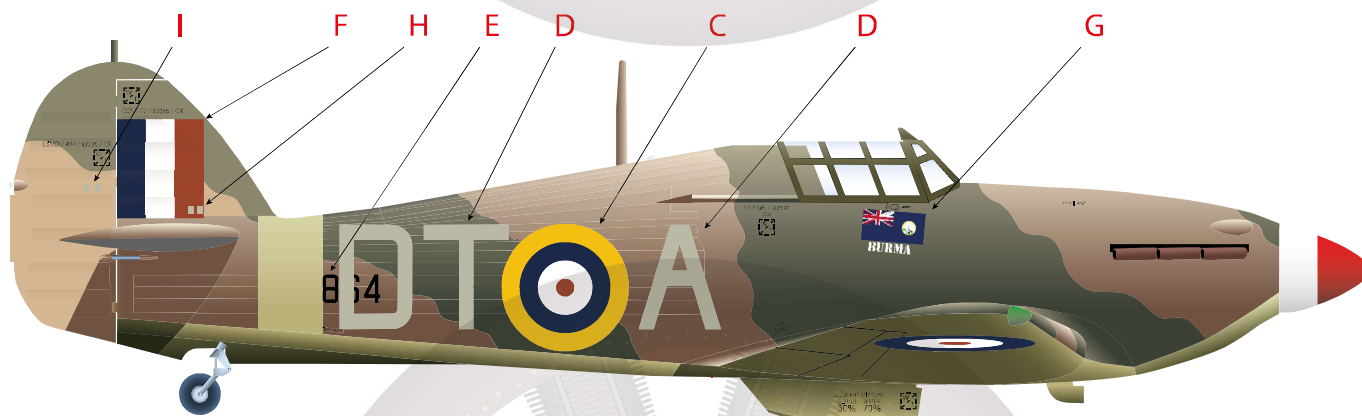
