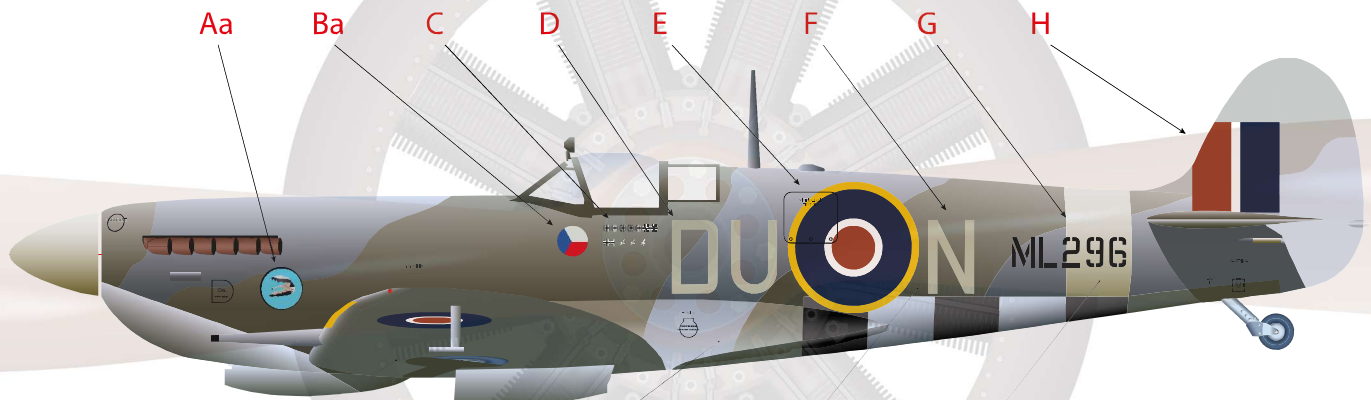


Spitfire Mk.IF IXC ML296 of No. 312 Squadron, RAF North Weald, March to October 1944.

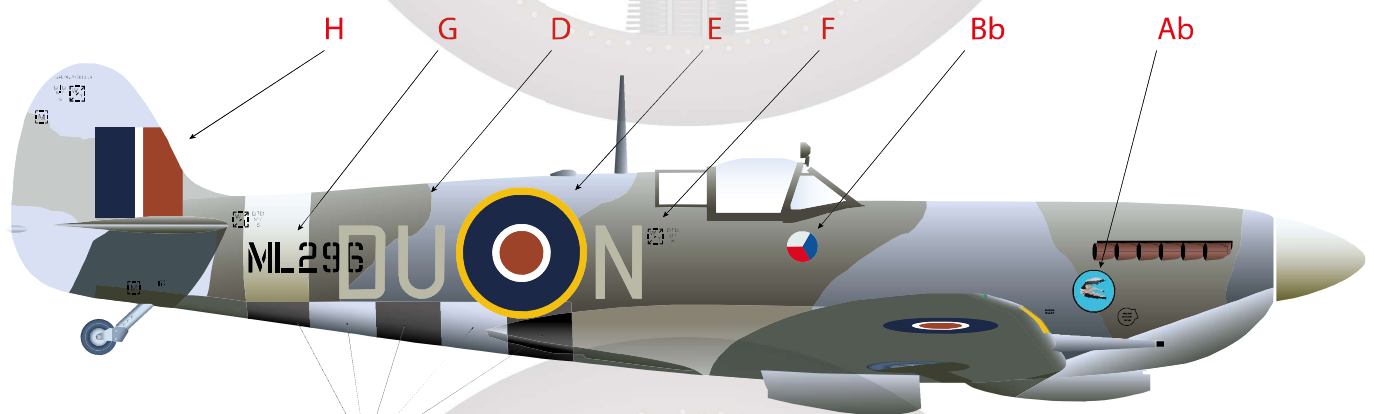

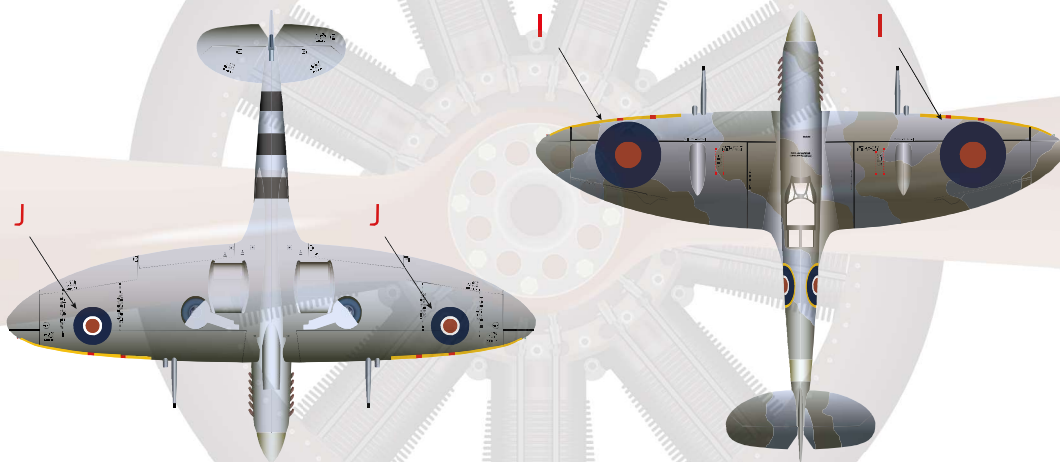

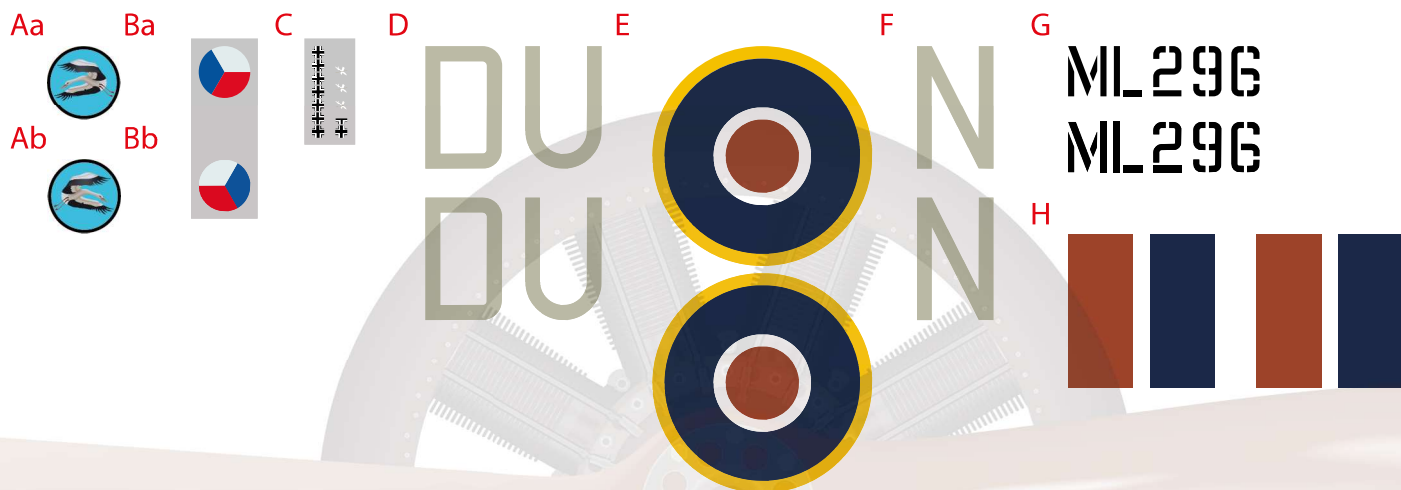
